International Drivers' Permit

This document is not a substitute for the law. In case of any misinformation, the Laws of Guyana shall prevail.

The International Drivers' Permit

Guyanese Nationals migrating to or visiting any Country that is a signatory to the 1968 Vienna Convention on Road Traffic, will be issued with an International Drivers' Permit.

It is important to note, the International Driving Permit will only be issued for the class of vehicle that you are currently authorised to drive in Guyana.



Applying for the International Drivers' Permit

Persons making an application for an International Drivers' Permit, must do so through the Guyana Revenue Authority's Licence Revenue Office. The application must provide all the requisite documents to the Licence Office in order to successfully obtain this permit:



Completed Application Form



Copy of Valid form of Identification (National ID ; bio-data page of Passport)



Original and copy of Guyanese Driver's Licence (must be valid for the next six (6) months)



Two passport-sized photographs



Permit Cost

The cost for an International Drivers' Permit is G\$2,000.00
