Individuals

This leaflet is not a substitute for the Law. In case of any misinformation, the Laws of Guyana shall prevail.

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A Taxpayer Identification Number, commonly referred to as a **TIN**, is a unique computer-generated number issued to each taxpayer.

WHO IS REQUIRED TO REGISTER FOR A TIN?

An Individual, Business, Government Department or Special Body, or taxpayers conducting business with the Central Bank, Public Corporation Government Department or Public Authority (inclusive of the Guyana Revenue Authority), must be a holder of a **Certificate of Registration**.

WHO IS EXEMPT?

The following persons are legally exempt from applying for a TIN:

- Any individual <u>UNDER</u> the age of fifteen (15) years.
- Temporary residents in Guyana, not in receipt of an income; where the stay does <u>not</u> exceed 183 days.
- A person who can prove to the GRA that he/she is **not** in receipt of an income.

CARICOM & International Applicants

Applicants in this category, making an application for work purposes are required to submit their work permit, **TIN Registration Form** and supporting document(s) to process their application.

<u>Tax Prepares | Accountants</u>

Tax Prepares / Accountants applying for a TIN on behalf of an individual, are required to stamp the **Registration Form** and supporting documents and submit same with a company letter, for processing.

WHERE TO APPLY?

All applications can be made at the GRA's Headquarters, 200-201 Camp St., Georgetown, or at any Integrated Regional Tax Office. Applications can also be submitted online via filing@gra.gov.gy

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

The following documents must be submitted along with your completed TIN Application Form:

- Local Proof of Address (utility bill, bank statement, any mail received via post, or a Testimony Form (if applicable).
- Form of Identification (Passport or National ID)
- Marriage Certificate (if applicable)
- Deed Poll (if applicable)
- Power of Attorney (If acting on behalf of another individual), and copy of the Power of Attorney's Passport or National Identification Card

Individuals will be required to pay a nominal fee when making an application for TIN, or when requesting a re-print:
